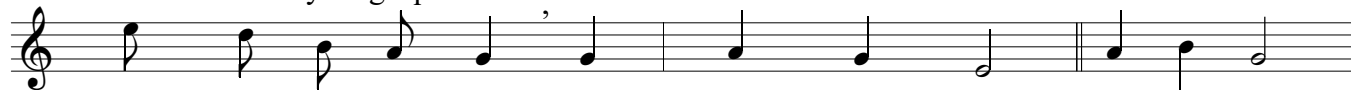

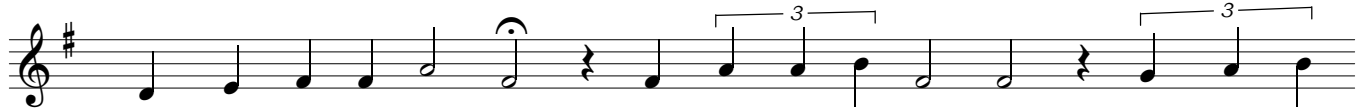
Children's Prayer

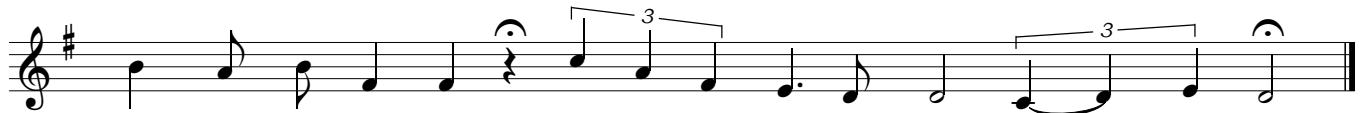
